Old World Stone



These rocks differ greatly in chemical composition and formation, and are the result of intense volcanic activity. Porphyry is characterized by very neat fissuring and percussion fracturing. It does not become smooth due to wear or slippery when it rains, and is unaffected by freezing and thawing. Porphyry (means purple in Greek) is a very dense, very colorful volcanic material. The red multi-blend is a burst of rusty burgundy tones with gold, taupe, and a little bit of gray. This material is very dense and does not allow water absorption. Application: factories, foundries, public works and residential use. Great for indoor or outdoor use especially around pools, decks, patios, walkways, kitchens or bathrooms. The surface texture is flat yet rough enough to make it naturally slip resistant.
